Name of activity	Misunderstanding
Description of activity	This game requires two people, who are sitting back to back. Person A will have an object and will have to describe it to Person B (without explicitly saying what it is). Person B will then have to draw it, based on person A's descriptions.
Who are the participants?	This activity is foreseen to strengthen Youth Workers, skills such as active listening, empathy, effective communication, and emotional communication.
Identification of the aims of the activity	Misunderstanding play improves creative communication. Finding creative ways to communicate, even if there are barriers, builds problem-solving skills.
Number of participants	At least 2
Duration	30 minutes
Materials for the activity	Chairs, objects
Identification of the competencies	Creative communication
Suggestions for the post-activation debriefing	In the whole-class discussion, bring out the skills that have been acted upon.
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
