Name of activity	Put yourself in female shoes- survival guide for women
Description of good practice	<p>A panoramic view on the woman through media, religion, socio-political matters and violence issues with an eye to the globalization influences which nowadays require the active participation of youth in the dimension not only of the local policy in favor of women but at European and International level too. They will help you to face and discuss womens' rights and gender equality with children and young people.</p>
